



# SPECIAL RECOGNITION AWARD

**Promoting students' overall academic development is the goal of the SCO Academic Excellence Award.**

Students that perform very well on Olympiad examinations in a variety of subjects are recognized for their efforts with a cash incentive of INR 10,000 as a Special Recognition incentive.

The student who receives the best cumulative score across all four Olympiad Exams taken in a given year is the scholarship winner for that class. Marks from the second level Olympiad in Math, Science, and Coding are taken into consideration.

One student from each class, from Classes 1 to 10, is chosen to receive a scholarship under the SCO Academic Excellence Award.

**In case of a tie, winner is decided on the basis of the following criteria -**

-Students scoring higher cumulative marks in the 1st level exams.

-Student scoring higher marks in 1st level exam in the order of Mathematics, Science and Coding.


-Students scoring higher rank in 2nd level exams in the order of Mathematics, Science and Coding.

# Guidelines

**Examination Center:** For Level 1 tests, the students' own schools will serve as the Olympiad center.

Medium of the Olympiads: English will be the medium of all Olympiads. Level 2 examinations will take place at a location chosen by SCO.

**Olympiad Time:** The test will take place during regular school hours.

**Registration Process:** When registering students with SCO, schools are required to fill out the SRF and SRS columns completely and legibly, and then turn in the forms by the deadline. It is asked that schools put the included posters in a visible location or on the notice board.

In order to administer the exam, schools are also asked to submit registration forms for a minimum of 10 pupils for each Olympiad. Only the schools should be used for student registration. If the school is registered, pupils' individual or direct registration might not be approved.

## Exam registration is available to schools through the following channels:

- Fill in and courier the registration forms.
- Fill in, scan and email the registration forms.

**Schools Codes:** A school's code is an exclusive alphanumeric code that SCO assigns to schools when they register for the SCO Olympiads; it differs from the CBSE code and other education boards' affiliation codes. If schools are unsure of their school codes, they can get in touch with the Raipur SCO office.

**Sample Questions/Material:** This prospectus is being delivered with sample questions and study materials for each class's Olympiad. These are also available for download at [blog.schoolconnectonline.com](http://blog.schoolconnectonline.com), the SCO website.

**Exam** – Every inquiry is of the objective kind. Negative marking does not exist. The school may choose any day from the list of alternatives to administer the exam, but it must make sure it is only held on that date. Every date will have a separate set of question papers. Exam cancellation could result from failure to comply to the deadline.

## Level 1 Awards –

- A comprehensive "E-Student Performance Report" that can only be seen through the SCO website and is only available to students who registered through the school is given to each participating student along with a "Certificate of Participation."
- Every participating student who registers on their own gets an elaborate "E-Student Performance Report" and a "E-Certificate of Participation."
- Certificates of Distinction and Medals of Distinction awarded to the top 25 zonal scorers in each class for each exam.

**School Gold Medal of Excellence/Hall of Fame/Outstanding** performance will be awarded was under :

- Top rank winner receives Gold Medal of Excellence for classes with 5 to 9 registrations.
- For 10 to 25 registrations/class – Gold Medal of Excellence to top 3 rank holders.
- If more than 25 people register for a class – Top 10% rank holders will receive a gold medal of excellence.

**Level 2 Exams:** For students who pass Level 1, they will take place in the second or third week of February. Students studying in classes 3 to 12 for IMO and ISO will be able to attend these. There is no additional cost to take the tests for the second level.

Students who meet any one of the three requirements below will be eligible to take the Olympiad Exam at the second level.

- Top 5% of students worldwide who appear for the first level exam, broken down by class.
- The top 25 rank holders in each class and zone.
- Class topper: a student who appears in a test and receives at least ten percent of the possible points from the class. The class topper with the best overall grade across all sections, in the event of section-wise registration, will advance to the second level.

The list of eligible pupils will be displayed on our website, [www.schoolconnectonline.com](http://www.schoolconnectonline.com), and distributed to the appropriate schools. Except for IMO and ISO, all Olympiad tests have a level 2.


**Admit Cards:** Prior to the level 2 exam, admit cards will be sent to the schools or uploaded on our website, [www.schoolconnectonline.com](http://www.schoolconnectonline.com).

**Following the exam:** The day following the Olympiad, the answer sheets must be returned to the SCO office. Within seven days of the exam, schools can make sure the answer sheets get to the SCO office.

SCO will review the response sheets. Students whose response sheets are not received within the allotted time may not be allowed to be evaluated by SCO.

**Result:** Following the submission of the answer papers, the results will be announced in around six to nine weeks.

**OMR:** Students must accurately complete each column on the OMR page. A student may not be ranked if they provide inaccurate or insufficient information. A sample OMR sheet is included with this prospectus and can be found on the SCO website.




